

Apply for Perkins funding for "Grow Your Own"

Apply now for Perkins funding for your high school Educators Rising and Grow Your Own programs. These programs aid teacher recruitment by supporting high school students who aspire to become educators. Career and technical education (CTE) programs are supported by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act, as amended by the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V), thus your school may be eligible for funds to support your Grow Your Own and Educators Rising programs.




Missouri NEA Summer Leadership



Caring Help for Education Endeavors by Retirees was formed by MNEA-Retired to be a public benefit by enhancing the learning conditions of Missouri's students. The CHEER grant program provides an opportunity for MNEA-Retired members to reach out to public school district employees, particularly early career educators, and provide financial and material resources.

This spring, MNEA-Retired awarded 34 CHEER grants to MNEA members, totaling \$11,632.88.
